

THE 2018 H.O.M.E. SPRING FORMAL – "STARRY NIGHT"

This is a lovely semi-formal evening of dinner, photos, entertainment and dancing for H.O.M.E. and Homeschool Connections high school students.

This is a homeschool event for homeschooled high school students between the ages of 14 (by 9/1/17) and 18 years of age. If you were homeschooled before enrolling in Running Start, high school juniors and seniors are welcome.

Parents and Teen guests, please read the statements below and click the "I Agree" box on the website event registration when you are done:

Attire: ABSOLUTELY NO DENIM is allowed by anyone on the Country Club grounds. This includes parents who drop off or pick up their teens. This is a Country Club rule.

Ladies: The ladies attire is modest, knee length (2" or more below fingertips) or floor length dresses or gowns. No plunging necklines, low cut backs or cutouts/see through fabric where undergarments may normally be seen. No more than 2" of midriff showing. If the attendee arrives at the door and it is determined they are inappropriately dressed, they will be asked to return to the event when they have made the appropriate changes to their attire. The decision of appropriateness is left to the sole discretion of the event committee chairperson. If an attendee is asked to leave and return because of the dress code and their decision is to not return, there will not be a refund of fees.

Gentlemen: Gentlemen's attire is expected to be dress slacks with shirts and ties - Jackets are optional but look great, so we strongly encourage them!

Conduct: All participant's actions while at the dance will be polite, well behaved, and honoring to Christ, whether dancing or on the side lines of the dance floor. There will be no vulgar language or inappropriate dance movements. In the event that the participant chooses to disregard this standard and the chaperones feel it is necessary to intervene, the parents will be called to take the student home. Any student who leaves the building for any reason may not return to the event, and their parents will be called.

Parents: This event will be well chaperoned. You may pick up your teen in the lobby. There will be coffee and tea in the seating area for parents who are early. The dance will end at 11:00pm and your teen will meet you in the lobby area. Please be aware that your teen will be photographed and a link to all photos will be emailed out to the guests. FYI This event is designed to be an evening specifically for teens. This means the music and dancing may be different from what some parents find enjoyable; however, this event is to be a wholesome opportunity for our young people to interact. We will have a professional music system and DJ with only clean lyrics. We will have a variety of music played including pop, rock, Christian and swing. There will be some slow music played. All dancing is to be tasteful. Chaperones will intercede any inappropriate dancing to help make the night more enjoyable for all those attending.
